ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 구입할 모자를 고르시오.

M: Hello. How may I help you?

W: Hi. Could you recommend a cap for my five-year-old daughter?

M: We have different kinds of caps. Which one would you like? We have animal-shaped caps and ones with an animal picture on them.

W: Animal-shaped caps? I like that. What kind of animals do you have?

M: We have rabbit and tiger-shaped ones. These have ears on the top. Which one do you prefer?

W: The one with rabbit ears on the top looks so cute! I think my daughter will like it.

M: Good choice. Do you want the cap with the number seven on it or without?

W: I'll buy the one with the number on it.

M: Okay.

2번 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 하는 말의 주제로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Daniel! You can't throw away those bottles like that!

M: Oh, why not?

W: You should separate the clear plastic bottles from the colored ones and all other plastic waste. It's a new policy.

M: Why do I have to do that? They're all the same.

W: No, they're not. The clear ones can be used for different purposes.

M: Oh, really? I didn't know that. Is there anything else I need to do?

W: You also have to peel off the labels because they can't be recycled.

M: I've never done that before. I've only washed inside the bottles.

W: That's just the basic step! Now you know all these ways to throw away plastic bottles properly, right?

W: I see. Today's Wednesday, right? How about tomorrow?

M: Well, I'd rather not. What about on Friday? I still want to be careful with my teeth until tomorrow.

W: Sure. Let's go there after school that day, then.

M: Jane, you look different. Have you been working out these days?

W: Actually, I've been doing yoga for the past three months.

M: I see. Any special reason you chose to do yoga? Maybe for peace of mind?

W: Not really. I had some mild shoulder pain. And I thought that yoga might help get rid of it.

M: Did it work?

W: Yeah, the pain is gone. Now I do yoga every day.

M: Good for you. I thought that yoga was only good to improve flexibility. I might try it.

W: You should. I highly recommend it.

M: I need your help. I have to print out my biology assignments. But the printer at home is not working.

W: Oh, the printer must have run out of ink.

M: I already checked, and there seems to be enough ink. I don't know why it's not working.

W: Did you ask your friend, Brian to print them out for you?

M: I did, but he didn't have any A4-sized paper at his house. Could you print them out at the printing shop on your way home?

W: Of course, I can. Just send me the files you want printed out.

M: Thanks, Mom. I'll send them right away.

6번 대화를 듣고, 여자의 의견으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: What's the matter? Is something bothering you?

M: Thank you for the suggestion. I'll talk to him about it.
